

Goals Wildlife Conservation Advocacy Southwest

1. Develop an educational program explaining the importance of native non-game species.

2. Provide service through volunteer work with other groups and organizations.

3. Network to change and update Chapter 17 — Game and Fish and Outdoor Recreation including:

- Require a New Mexico hunting license for all hunting.
- Native species classified as non-game species and unprotected furbearers must be included in New Mexico Statutes.
- Mandatory harvest reporting to the New Mexico Department of Game and Fish required for all native species.
- Bag Limits, seasonal restrictions, and game management unit specifications must be established for all native species based on current wildlife management science.
- Modify the exceptions in the general rules in NM hunting regulations whereby the rules apply to all game, native non-game, and native furbearer species.
